The bath is at mid-passage. A separate shower that may also be used as a small tub. A Thetford marine toilet. A



wash basin recessed in a generous simulated marble countertop. Three view-positioned mirrors, enclosing two spacious medicine chests. A window skylight, electric fan, and two-level lighting system. And, of course, electric outlets for your personal appliances.

Immediately across the passageway is a double-door, cedar lined closet. The built-in light switch, mirror, and drawers provide the utmost convenience. As do the two privacy curtains that turn the central passageway into a dressing room, with access to the bath.

Come forward to the galley. Bright, light, and loaded with conveniences. An 8 cubic foot electric refrigerator/freezer. An eye-level oven (microwave optional). A four-burner LPG stove. A built-in garbage bin. A double stainless steel sink with single hot and cold water control, plus an additional spigot for purified drinking water. A built-in



blender. Loads of counter space, with covers for the sinks and stove, too. A unique spice compartment, a slide out towel rack, and ample cupboards and doors with recessed, locking handles.

Glance around the main cabin. It's made for all-around use; easily converting to an entertainment center, dining room, or bedroom, as needed. Overhead, generous cabinets provide ample storage. And there's a hide-away vacuum system, too.

Up front is the driver's domain. Comfortable control. A swivel bucket seat. Multiple-position tilting steering wheel and column. Power assist steering and braking. Cruise control. A full range of automotive instrumentation. Plus a unique systems console that tells driver and co-pilot all living systems status at the touch of a finger. And AM/FM stereo tape deck, and air conditioning.

Three distinctive cabin configurations are available, as shown on the last



page. Each is tailored to a unique lifestyle.

Suffice it to say that domestic systems—heating, air conditioning, water, LPG, electric, and waste—are more than adequately provided for. As is interior and exterior storage room. Full details can be found on the last page.

Beneath all this beauty, however, is the most beautiful thing about the FMC Motor Coach: it's a superbly designed, totally unique vehicle that rides, handles, and performs with an ability not unlike that of a luxury motor car.

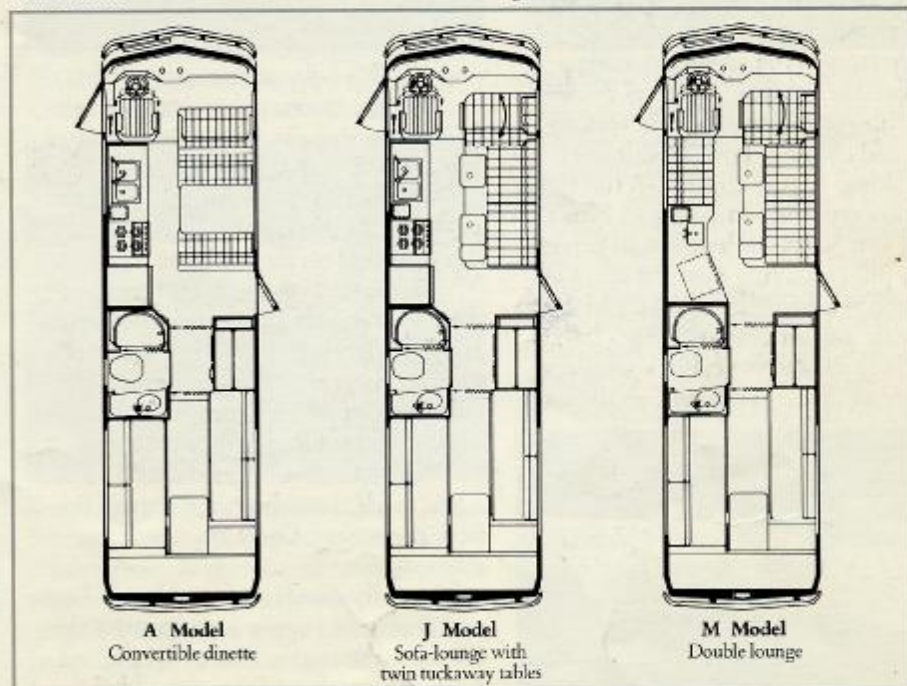
