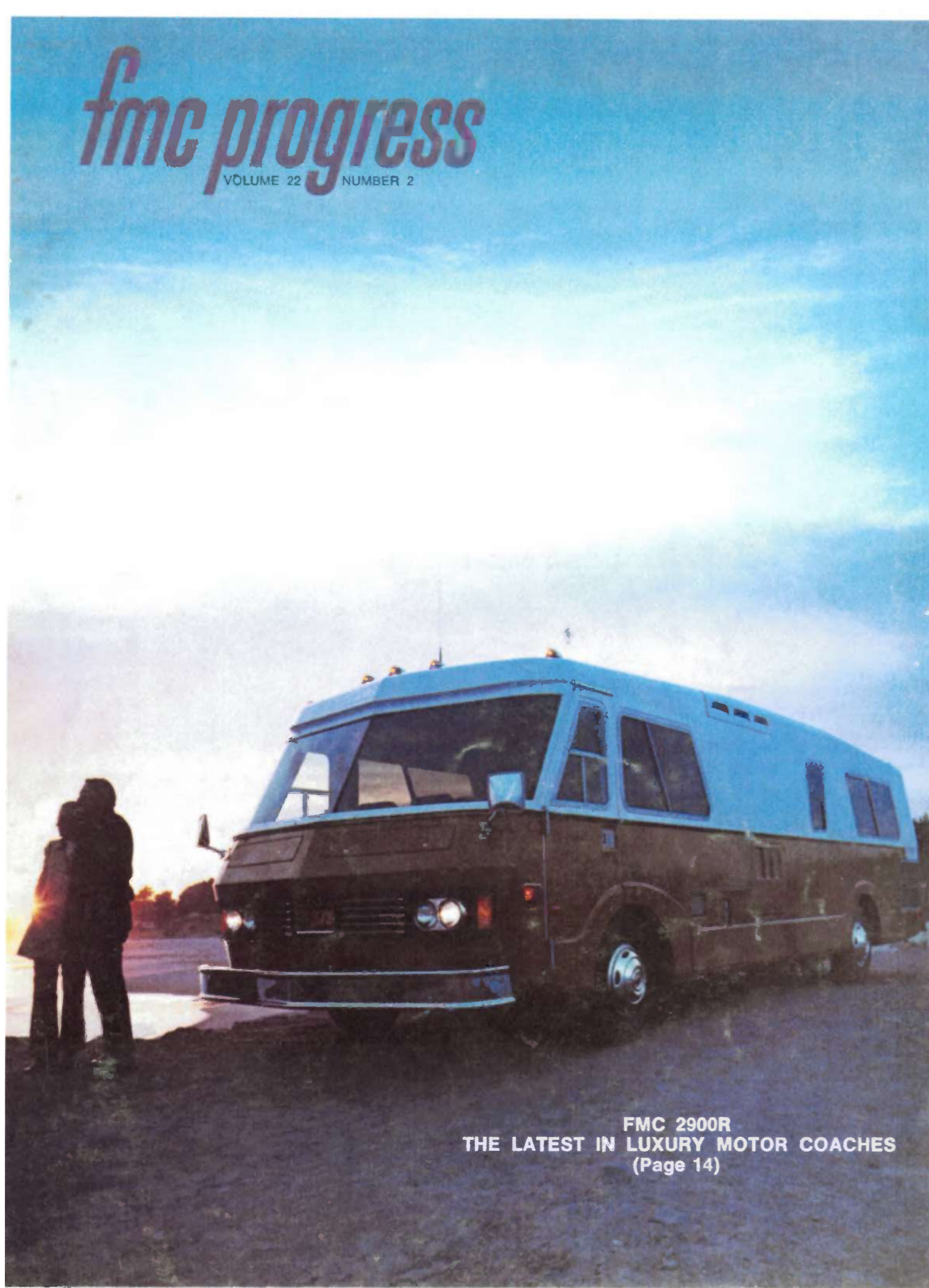

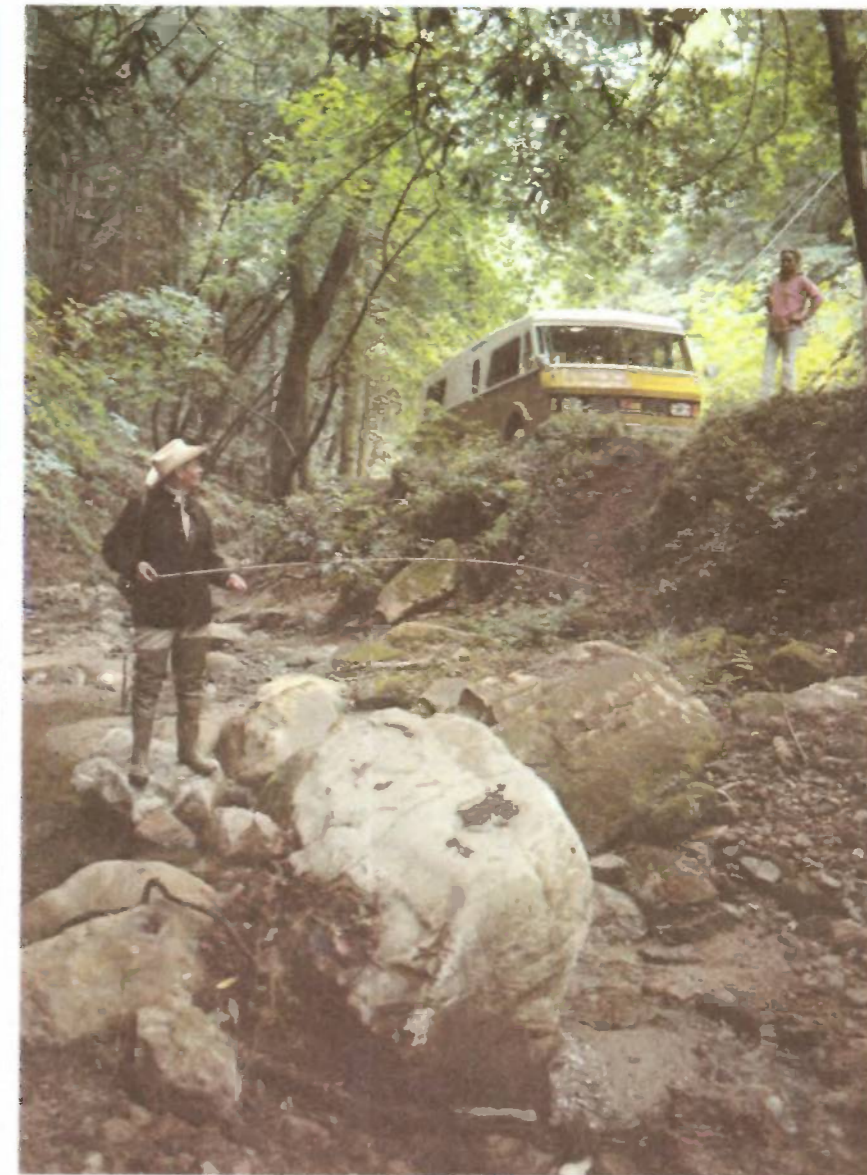

fmc 2900R a milestone in motor coaching

*FMC enters the recreational
vehicle field*

There's a totally new way to answer the "call of the open road." It's called motor coaching, and it's a way of life that can now offer the ultimate in ease and comfort to travelers who yearn to visit far-away places.

The new pacesetter in the rapidly growing recreational vehicles field is the FMC 2900R, a complete, self-contained motor coach. A product of FMC Corporation's Recreational Vehicle Division, Santa Clara, California, it is the first production coach designed from the ground up as a "home on wheels."

As the top of the line version of a

completely new series of coaches planned by the company, the FMC 2900R sets the highest standards yet achieved for ride comfort, performance, safety, and interior and exterior styling. One of the largest motor homes on the road today, the vehicle is 29 feet long, 8 feet wide, 8 feet 4 inches high, and is powered by a rear-mounted Chrysler 440 cubic inch V-8 engine.

Total living comfort for four adults is provided in the spacious coach. A living room with "picture" windows converts readily into ample bedroom

quarters for two. A luxurious, completely equipped bathroom/dressing room offers all the conveniences of home. The kitchen consists of a four-burner stove, refrigerator/freezer, oven, double sink, ample counter and storage space, and an adjacent dinette for four, which converts into a bed.

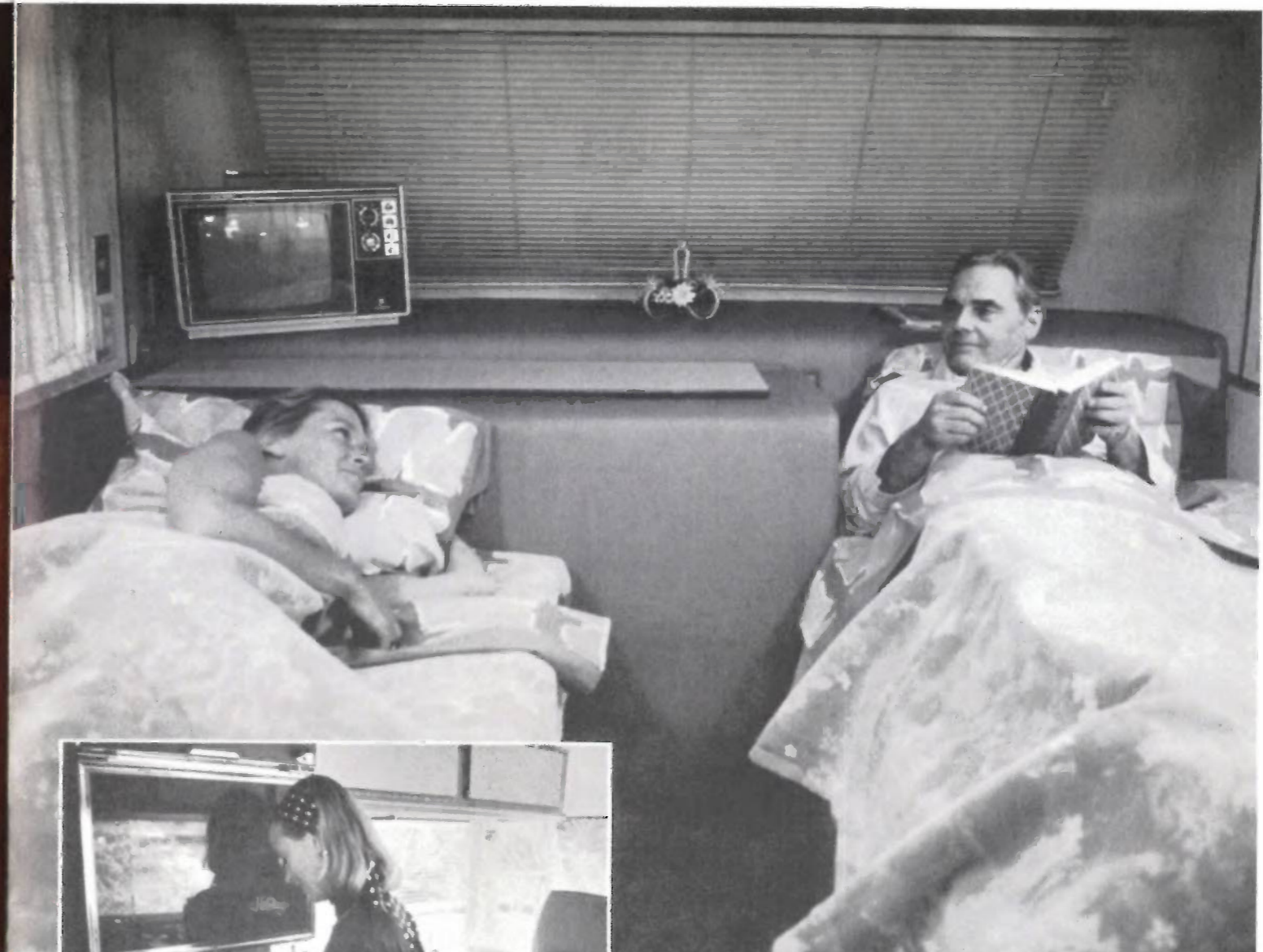
Up front, the *FMC 2900R* is equipped with an adjustable, swivel mounted seat for the driver, and comfortable

seating for 4 passengers. An automatic transmission, power steering and brakes, padded dashboard with a full complement of instruments in easy view, and full visibility through large windows and generous sized mirrors simplify the task of driving.

More than 30 years experience in producing military and civilian vehicles have gone into the creation of the new *FMC* motor coach. Since World War II, *FMC* has developed and built many unique and versatile military vehicles that have consistently met the most exacting performance demands. In addition,

FMC has pioneered in the field of mechanized harvesting equipment, built specialized transport vehicles, railroad freight cars, and compact grounds care equipment, such as tractors and mowers.

First deliveries of the luxurious motor home, which will sell in the \$21,000 class, are scheduled for this Fall to western states dealers. A nationwide network of established motor home dealers will receive vehicles during early 1973. It is anticipated that additional facilities will be set up throughout the U. S. to service the new *FMC 2900R* and recreational vehicles of all types.
